In Memoriam

Lynn C. Imergoot

MOAHPERD lost an energetic and dedicated leader when Lynn C. Imergoot died in a car accident on July 24, 2009. Lynn was co-editor of the *MOAHPERD Journal*.

Lynn worked in the Athletic Department at Washington University in St. Louis during the academic year and spent summers working at residential camps in the east. The accident occurred while she was driving from camp to a scheduled dentist appointment.

Lynn was 60 years old and moved to Missouri in 1973 to work at Washington University. She grew up in Bronx, New York, attended Lehman College in New York, and received her Master's degree from the University of Illinois-Urbana-Champaign. In her early years at Washington University she was director of women's and co-ed intramurals. She served as coordinator of women's athletics from 1977 through 1984, as Title IX was implemented, and then as assistant athletic director from 1984 to 2005. She was the first coach of women's tennis at Washington University, starting in 1975 and coaching until 2005. Her tennis teams compiled a record of 435-164 (.726), made seven NCAA tournament appearances, and had six players earn All-America distinctions. She also helped the Athletic Department introduce the other women's varsity sports. Following back surgery in early 2006, she served as associate director of club and intramural sports.

Lynn's tenure as co-editor of the *MOAHPERD Journal* began with the 1988 issue. She received several MOAHPERD awards, including the Helen Manley Award in 1984, the Robert M. Taylor Professional Service Award in 1994, and the Missouri State Pathfinder Award in 1996-97. Lynn received the MOAHPERD Scholar Award in 1990 and the Central District Scholar Award in 1992. She was an active member of the Representative Assembly, speaking out on many issues and suggesting actions to improve the Association and its publications. Her scholar awards recognized the many articles she published.

Several non-profit organizations benefitted from Lynn's time. She served a term as President of the Women's Physical Education Club of St. Louis & Vicinity. She served for two years as co-chair of the Women of Worth awards dinner sponsored by the Gateway Chapter of the Older Women's League. She worked on the Girls and Women in Sports Day activities sponsored by the Jewish Community Centers Association and also worked at the tennis venue for the Senior Olympics.

Lynn is survived by son Douglas, 31, daughter Jennifer, 28, granddaughter Tamia, 9, and sister Amy Kossak of New Jersey.

Lynn will be dearly missed by MOAHPERD members and leaders for the work she did for the organization, her humor, and the ray of sunlight she brought to every encounter with a fellow member.
